## THE VAT REVERSE CHARGE MECHANISM

The Chelco VAT International Academy continues its series of high-level VAT educational events with a morning seminar focusing on the mechanics of the Reverse Charge Mechanism.

The Managing Director of Chelco VAT and Lead Instructor of the Academy, Alexis Tsielepis, together with fellow Director, Panayiotis Panayi, will analyse when the reverse charge is used, how it works and how it should be reflected in the books and VAT returns of taxable persons in Cyprus. The seminar will cover the different scenarios where VAT must be discharged through reverse charge with relevant examples for discussion.

- Intra-community trade of goods;
- Receipt of services from abroad;
- Domestic reverse charge transactions (e.g. services in the construction industry, sale of scrap metal);
- Transactions where the supplier is not established in the Member State of supply;
- Trade of goods with triangular simplification.
